## In fall 2006, a group of Escondido residents and community leaders came together to create Escondido Community Foundation (ECF).

Working in partnership with San Diego Foundation, the purpose of this charitable foundation is to increase responsible and effective philanthropy to provide for the future of Escondido through a community endowment.

### Grantmaking                      \$4.2 Million

Since 2007, more than \$4 million has been granted to nonprofits serving Escondido, including contributions made to After-the-Fire Fund. ECF also partnered with the City of Escondido to grant \$1.5 million to nonprofit organizations that serve the city.
